PROPS: Bench, baseball gloves, bats

COSTUMES: Baseball uniforms and caps

SOUND: Wireless microphones

LIGHTING: General stage

SETTING: A baseball dugout

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The players enter the dugout, very disgusted and frustrated.

KYLE: I can't believe it! This is the worst game ever!

WADE: Did you see those guys? They were creaming us out there!

JON: Creaming is putting it mildly.

WADE: Guys, we can't go out there again. They're going to kill us.

KYLE: I know! They're so fast and strong. And they hit the ball so hard.

JON: My mom's out there, guys. If I go out there and play... I'm gonna be so embar-

rassed. I won't get dessert for a week.

KYLE: I vote we quit.

WADE: I quit too.

JON: Tell the coach, game's over. We're done.

COACH enters as the players start taking off their hats and cleats.

COACH: Okay, boys. Our turn at bat.

JON: Sorry, Coach, we quit.

COACH: You quit??

KYLE: Dude, we're not going to play any more.

COACH: What are you talking about?

JON: Coach, look at those guys. Look at the score. There's no way that we're going to

beat these guys.

WADE: Yeah, Coach. This game is as good as over.

COACH: What do you mean over? It's the bottom of the FIRST!!!

Pause, to let the joke sink in with the audience.

WADE: So?
