GENRE: Comedy

SYNOPSIS: A college professor teaches his students that they all must hate one another because they don't all agree on everything.

People who disagree must also hate each other. It's a hard skit, and it should not be used as a stand alone – except possibly in some college settings where the humor might have a broad appeal.

CHARACTERS:

PROFESSOR PRETENSION
JIM, KENT, SARAH, and DONNA—college students

PROPS: College classroom desks and chairs, a chalkboard and chalk

COSTUMES: Shirt and tie for the prof, regular clothes for the others, including a Red Sox hat for Jim.

SOUND: Five wireless microphones

LIGHTING: General stage

SETTING: A classroom

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The students are sitting in desks. JIM is wearing a Red Sox hat or shirt or jacket. The PRO-FESSOR walks in and stands by a chalkboard

PROF: Good afternoon, class. I'm Professor Pretension, and this is Political Science 101. Who can tell me something about politics? Anyone?

JIM: Professor? Politics is like Republicans and Democrats.

PROF: Yes, very good. Here in America, we have a two party system.

KENT: Sounds like my weekend.

The students laugh.

PROF: Yes, right. Anyway, we have two political parties: Republican and Democrat. My next question is: how do you know which one you belong to?

SARAH: Which one has Bud on tap?

The students laugh.

PROF: If I may go on, each party has different beliefs about the key issues of our day. For example, how many of you here think it's okay to own a gun?

KENT and DONNA raise their hands.

Then you two are Republicans.

KENT: Cool, Republicans represent!

KENT and DONNA high five.

SARAH: So since we don't think it's okay to own guns that makes us Democrats?

PROF: Yes.

JIM: Wow, I'm a Democrat.

KENT: Can we still go to the same parties on Friday night?

PROF: No, I'm afraid you can't.

DONNA: Excuse me?

PROF: You can't go to the same parties. Not Republicans and Democrats.
