Lights up on MARTHA. She sits in front of a computer. She is obviously very upset. She moves the mouse around and clicks. She stops, horrified.

MARTHA: Frank! Fraaaaaaaaank!!!

FRANK: (Offstage) I'm a little busy right now, honey!

MARTHA: Frank! This is important! I need you to come up to Johnny's room!

FRANK: Babe, I'm really kinda in the middle of something here!

MARTHA: What? What is so important!?

FRANK: Troy is telling Gabriella that that he really does want to audition for the high school musical!

MARTHA: Oh, for crying out loud! Get in here!

FRANK: OK! OK! I'm coming.

MARTHA: (To herself) This is awful. Just awful.

FRANK: (Entering, singing badly) Get'cha head in that game! Your head's gonna get'cha – get'cha – (To MARTHA) OK, so what is so darn important?

MARTHA: (Indicating computer screen) Look at this.

FRANK sits next to MARTHA and looks at the computer. His face changes from delight to horror. He is stunned by what he sees. He looks at MARTHA.

FRANK: That's...

MARTHA: Uh-huh.

FRANK: It's...

MARTHA: Uh-huh.

FRANK: Johnny's been looking at...

MARTHA: Uh-huh. (Pause) Johnny's been looking at garbage.

FRANK: That's not just garbage. That's...that's...that's...trash!

MARTHA: Oh, you haven't even seen the worst of it yet. Look at this website. (She types) Do you see that?

FRANK: Oh, no. Oh my gosh. I...I...what website is this?
