A table is at stage right with a sign that says, "RETURNS." Carla is behind the counter, dressed like a Big Box Store employee. James enters, stage left, and walks to the counter carrying a large shopping bag.

CARLA: Welcome to Big Box Express*, may I help you?

*You can sub in Target, Wal-Mart, etc if desired.

JAMES: I'd like to make a return, please.

CARLA: Was it a Christmas gift?

JAMES: Yes it is.

CARLA: Let me guess, granny thought you were a Power Rangers man, and you're really a Star Wars man.

JAMES: Nah, just wasn't really something I wanted.

CARLA: Well, let's see what we have here.

James sets the bag on the counter. Carla opens the bag. She looks inside. Her eyes pop open wide.

CARLA: OH MY GOODNESS! (shakes her head in disbelief) OH MY GOODNESS!

JAMES: What's the matter?

CARLA: You want to return THIS?????

JAMES: Yes, please.

CARLA: Kid - DO YOU KNOW WHAT THIS IS???

JAMES: Yes.

CARLA: Do you know what it DOES???

JAMES: Yeah. Pretty silly if you ask me.

CARLA: SILLY???? Kid, we had parents fighting each other in the aisles over this toy! I saw an old woman climb to the top of Aisle 7 and do a five star frog splash on another customer, just so she could give this to her grandkid.

JAMES: Sounds pretty silly to me.
