GENRE: Comedy

DIRECTOR'S TIP: Glen should come across as sincere. The whole scene unfolds as a cute romance... until Heidi starts to expose him for who he is.

TIME: Under 5 minutes

CAST BREAKDOWN: 2M, 1F

TOPIC: Dating

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE: 1 Samuel 16:7

CHURCH YEAR SEASON: Valentine's Day; Any

SUGGESTED USE: Student ministry or singles/college ministry.

CHARACTERS:

GLEN - a single Christian guy

HEIDI - a single Christian girl

TIM - another Christian guy, a bit dumber than Glen

PROPS: A bookshelf full of Christian books; cell phones

COSTUMES: Casual clothes

SOUND: Wireless mics if desired;

LIGHTING: General stage

SETTING: A Christian bookstore

The setting is a Christian bookstore. Heidi is browsing some books by C.S. Lewis as Glen approaches her, making his move.
