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THE TAPE by Scott Crain

SAMMY: What do you call this? Emergency services should be notified for the smell alone.

She takes a step in and accidentally kicks a beer bottle, sending it skittering across the floor.

I like what you've done with the place. What do you call this motif—Early American Recluse?

RICK: (eyes still on the TV) You didn't bring a Bible, did you? Cuz I don't want any God-stuff in here.

SAMMY: Relax. (prying open her purse and showing him the inside) I'm unarmed. God-stuff?

RICK: Bibles, tracts, crucifixes, holy water. Bric-a-brac of the self-righteous.

SAMMY: I thought you were just depressed. Have you turned vampire, too?

RICK: I'm not depressed.

SAMMY: Oh here we go.

RICK: Some people get their hearts broken and go mad with grief. Not me. I've gone sane. Getting dumped by Stephanie actu—

SAMMY: (exhausted by this, trying to cut him off) She didn't "dump" you...
