SUGGESTED USE: Sermon starter, worship service

CHARACTERS:

DANNY - 18-20 years old TERI - 18-20 years old

PROPS: A test (few pages of questions and answers, i.e. a

college exam)

COSTUMES: Contemporary

SOUND: Two wireless microphones

LIGHTING: General stage

SETTING: Unspecified

DIRECTOR'S TIP: While not strictly called for, it may be helpful to have Danny (and perhaps Teri) wearing backpacks slung over their shoulders in order to help 'sell' the scene.





THE TEST by Tim Bass

Lights up on DANNY. He addresses the audience.

DANNY: So I'm on my way to a class when I hear this voice behind me.

TERI: (Stepping into light.) Hey, Danny! Danny!

DANNY: (To audience) It's Teri, this girl I took some classes with.

(To TERI) Hey. Teri. What's going on? How are you?

TERI: Good. I'm good. You?

DANNY: Good. Great. Fine. What's up?

TERI: Just headed to work. I'm doing a few hours a week at the campus coffee shop. Thought that was you—thought I'd say hello. Haven't seen you since Chemistry.

DANNY: Yeah—that was tough. I barely made it out with a C. How'd you do?

TERI: OK. Not bad. A minus.

DANNY: Whoa.

TERI: It wasn't easy. Anyway...where you headed?

DANNY: New class. Organizational Behavior.

TERI: With Dr. Brendlinger?

DANNY: The very same.

TERI: Ouch!

DANNY: That bad?

TERI: Worse.

DANNY: Ouch!

TERI: Precisely.
