Try not to overdo the characterizations and just keep the banter moving loud, fast and clear. 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Lights up on JILL. She sits behind a computer or on a sofa/chair with a laptop. She is very focused on what she is doing. JERRY enters.

JILL: Wha ...? Oh! Hey.

JERRY: What are you doing?

JILL: Oh! What's doin'...right. I'm checking out places for our vacation.

JERRY: Ah. Yes. I can't believe we've waited this long to take a vacation. Well, let's take a very long look at this. Have you found something yet?

JILL: Yeah, I've narrowed it down, I think, to just a few places.

JERRY: Okay. Whatcha got?

JILL: Okay, here goes. First choice—Orlando.

JERRY: Orlando? Florida?
