Lights up on ADAM. He is standing with several shopping bags. He appears lost, dejected. TINA walks up.

TINA: Uh, excuse me...sir...are you all right?

ADAM: Wha...what? Oh. Uh, yeah...yes...I'm uh...I'm fine.

TINA: Are you sure? You look, I don't know, lost?

ADAM: No. I'm just...I was just standing here and I had these packages in my hand and I looked down at them, at the clothes and books and gifts and all this stuff, and I looked up and I realized it. I've lost hope.

TINA: No! No. Don't say that. You haven't. You can't believe that. You must not believe

that!

JACK: (Walking up) Is everything okay?

ADAM: Oh, sure, I just...

TINA: He's lost hope!

JACK: Lost hope?

TINA: Yes.

ADAM: Look, I just...

JACK: C'mon, man! Buck up!

TINA: Buck up? That's all you got? Buck up? This man has lost hope. Hope is gone. Byebye hope. Adios hope and all you got is, "Buck up?"

JANET: (Walking up) What's going on?

JACK/TINA: He's lost hope!

JANET: No!
