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Lights up. Josie is crossing from stage left to right, carrying her book bag. She stops, looks up, and begins to pray.

Booger enters from stage left, walks up to Josie.

**BOOGER:** Hey Josie? (sniff/snorts)

JOSIE: (she turns, hiding her annoyance at the interruption) Yes?

**BOOGER:** Did you do the math homework already?

JOSIE: Yes.

Booger stands there.

What?

**BOOGER:** It's hard. (sniff/snort)

JOSIE: Yeah. It's hard.

Booger exits stage left.

Lord, I know I'm still young, but I am asking you to prepare a place for me. Doesn't matter where. You know I like to travel. So if you need someone to go to Africa or Asia or even an inner city in America, send me where you need me. Send me where I can do the most--

Booger enters stage left.

**BOOGER:** (*sniff/snort*) Hey Josie?

**JOSIE:** (pauses, a little more annoyed) What?

**BOOGER:** Did you get number five?

JOSIE: Yes.

**BOOGER:** Did you come up with false?

JOSIE: False?
