SUGGESTED USE: Worship Service, Bible Study

CHARACTERS: Ted ~ A wedding guest

Susan ~ A wedding guest

Offstage Voice ~ Best man at the wedding

PROPS: 1) Two champagne glasses

2) A table with six or eight chairs around it (wedding reception style)

3) Appropriate decorations (flowers, plates, etc.) at the table (optional)

COSTUMES: Dressy clothing, appropriate for a wedding reception

SOUND: Two wireless mics; sound effect of a happy wedding crowd

LIGHTING: General stage

SETTING: A wedding reception

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TED and SUSAN sit in front of a round table, holding champagne glasses.

OFFSTAGE VOICE: A toast to the bride and groom!

TED and SUSAN cheer along with the crowd offstage.

SFX: happy wedding crowd.

TED: To the happy couple.

SUSAN: Cheers.

TED: I don't think we've met. I'm Ted.

SUSAN: Susan.

TED: With the bride?

SUSAN: Old roommates. In college, back in Ohio. You?

TED: Cousin of the groom, twice removed. Kinda grew up together. Weren't you sitting

with someone?

SUSAN: He's over there. Talking with the maid of honor for the past 20 minutes.

TED: Sorry. I didn't mean to...

SUSAN: Don't worry. He's not my boyfriend or anything. I thought I saw you at the wed-

ding with a thin, smiley girl?

TED: My sister. She's too skinny and always happy. You said you came from Ohio?

SUSAN: For college. Moved to Los Angeles after graduation. Got a job.

TED: Doing ...?

SUSAN: Advertising. Slogans, labels, image...

TED: Presentation.

SUSAN: It's all about presentation. The art of looking good and showing your best side

first.
