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Lights up on five chairs; JIM is seated. In front is a coffee table with chips, dip, soda, etc. There is also a notebook and pen/pencil on the table. JEFF walks in. As each person enters, they greet each other.

JEFF: (Entering) Jim.

JIM: Jeff.

JAY: (Entering) Jeff. Jim.

JIM: Jay.

JEFF: Jay.

JAKE: (Entering) Jay. Jim. Jeff.

JAY/JIM/JEFF: Jake.

JOHN: (Entering) Jake. Jim. Jay. Jeff.

JIM: John.

JEFF: Johnny.

JAY: Johnny.

JAKE: John.

JOHN: How's everybody?

JIM: Just jake, John.

JOHN: Good.

JIM: Alright. The game starts in about ten minutes! Grab yourself a cold one, some chips, whatever. I think we're gonna tear 'em up this week!

JAY: You can say that again. Did you see that interception Smith made last week?

JEFF: I could not believe my eyes!

JAKE: Smith?

JAY: The other Smith.

JAKE: Oh.

JOHN: I think Smith turned that game around against the Giants.
