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Two chairs are at stage right and left. Both chairs have coat hangers beside them. The chair at stage right has a purse on it as well. JEN and MIKE enter in cap and gown carrying diplomas. They take off their caps and robes and hang the robes on the hangers. They each pick up the robes, caps and diplomas. JEN picks up her purse. They face each other.

JEN: Well?

MIKE: Well?

JEN: I guess this is it.

MIKE: I guess so.

JEN: You all set to go away next year.

MIKE: Yeah, just about. You?

JEN: (Shrugs) I'm getting there.

MIKE: Great. (Pause) Well, keep in touch.

JEN: Yeah, you too.

MIKE: Okay.

JEN: Bye.

MIKE: Goodbye, Jen.

JEN exits right. MIKE exits left. They both run on frantically, facing each other and drop everything.
