THE WALL OF JERICHO by John Cosper

A wall is set up at center. Connie and Jerry are dressed as soldiers - modern or ancient - and as the scene begins, both are hidden behind the wall. Connie stands up, as if waking from a nap, stretching. She looks over the wall and sees the people of Israel below.

CONNIE: Hey, Jerry, check it out. The lunatics are back!

Jerry stands up, looks over the wall.

JERRY: I don't believe it!

CONNIE: I know!

JERRY: Here they come, marching around the city with all their men, women and chil-

dren.

CONNIE: Ohhh I'm so scared!

JERRY: (yells over the wall) Hey! I thought the parade was yesterday!

CONNIE: And the day before!

JERRY: Where are the marching bands?

CONNIE: Forget the marching bands! I wanna see some big balloons!

JERRY: Yeah, yeah, where's Spider-Man?

CONNIE: And Snoopy? I want to see Snoopy!

JERRY: (to Connie) Can you believe those chumps? What do they think they're doing,

looking for a weak spot in the wall?

CONNIE: There are no weak spots! This is Jericho! They can't get through our wall!

JERRY: And if they think they're coming over, I got a thousand gallons of hot oil here

says they can't!

CONNIE: (yelling over the wall) Hey, you with the sword, did your mommy say it was okay

for you to play with that thing?

JERRY: Careful you don't hurt yourself!

CONNIE: Yeah, you could put an eye out with that thing!

JERRY: (to Connie) Who are those guys anyway? Where did they come from?

CONNIE: They're the Hebrews.
