GENRE: Drama

SYNOPSIS: Four actors make reference to Elijah's experience at Mt. Horeb when he heard God's voice in a way he hadn't expected.

Although this is a short sketch, let the pacing move quickly as it opens as if this is a conversation in progress. When Character 1 says, "Are you sure?" slow down the pacing to create a more pensive thoughtful mood.

TOPIC: Listening to God

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE: 1 Kings 19:9-21

CHURCH YEAR SEASON: Any

SUGGESTED USE: Worship Service, Bible Study, Prayer Service

CHARACTERS: Four characters, either gender, any age

PROPS: Modern clothing

COSTUMES: First-century peasant costumes. Mary must have a simple head covering that she will use to swaddle the baby.

SOUND: Four wireless mikes

LIGHTING: General Stage

SETTING: Empty stage

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#1: What do you think God sounds like?

#2: I don't know. Probably like the roaring of a mighty wind.

#3: No, I think it's more like the rumble of an earthquake.

#4: Oh no. I'm sure it sounds more like a raging inferno..

#1: (doubtfully) I don't know...

#2: Oh yes. Definitely. It's like a hurricane...giant currents of air beating against a house.

#3: I'm sorry, but it's like the deafening noise of rocks tumbling down the mountain... or earth moving with tremendous force.

#4: No really. First, there's an explosion, you see, and then the swirling of a consuming fire.

#1: Are you sure? I mean, I've never heard God speak that way.

#2: Really?

#3: Never?

#4: That's hard to believe. (pause) Then...what do you think God sounds like?

#1: Well, I hear Him in a soft voice...sort of low...and sometimes even...sweet.

#2: Sounds more like...

#3: Yeah, it does sound more like...

#4: Why, that's...

#1: Yes, sometimes God speaks to me in a voice that sounds...more like a whisper.
