JAN DEAN

PROPS: A legal pad, pen, magazine, and church bulletin/newsletter

COSTUMES: Contemporary

SOUND: Two wireless microphones

LIGHTING: General stage

SETTING: A living room

Drama Ministry

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Lights up on a living room. JAN and DEAN are sitting. JAN has a legal pad and a pen in her hand. DEAN is reading a magazine. Silence. JAN stares at DEAN. DEAN reads. JAN begins tapping the pen on the pad. DEAN reads. JAN clears her throat. DEAN reads.

JAN: ... have you heard a word that I've said?

DEAN: ...huh?

JAN: I'm running off with Antonio Banderas and having his love child.

DEAN: ...okay...

JAN: Honey.

DEAN: Uh huh...

JAN: Honey!

DEAN: Yeah...

JAN: HONEY!

DEAN: What...?

JAN: Can you work with me on this thing?

DEAN: Do we have to do this now?

JAN: Yes.

DEAN: Fine.

JAN: Okay.

DEAN: Okay.

JAN: Right...so...

DEAN: So...

JAN: Well, give me your thoughts. Help me here.

DEAN: Okay. Let's back up. You want...

JAN: We! We want.

DEAN: We want...to start a small group.
